

BARRED PLYMOUTH ROCKS

BARNEVELDER

Originating from Holland this is a very cold tolerant breed. They are a gorgeous burnt orange with thick black lacing throughout. They are a medium-sized bird laying dark brown eggs.



RHODE ISLAND REDS & BLUES

If you are striving for the "Peak" in egg production The Blues are a hybrid of reds and the Austrolorps and are Blue, Black and Red colored



WELSUMMER

Dutch breed known for its cold hardy, calm temperament and their production of dark reddish-brown eggs. They are a curious and intelligent breed suited well for backyard



CUCKOO MARANS

The Cuckoo Maran is a rare breed that adapts well to confinement. Marans are known best for their distinctive chocolate brown egg.
